The purpose of this Final Report (Report Number 24-08-004-03-330) is to formally advise you of the results of a Quality Control Review (QCR) the U.S. Department of Labor, Office of Inspector General (OIG), conducted of the following audit performed by Thompson, Williams, Biediger, Kastor & Young, L.C. under the Federal Single Audit Act and Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Circular A-133 (A-133):

Single Audit of the Alamo Workforce Development, Inc. for the fiscal years ended June 30, 2005 and 2004.

The objectives of the QCR were to 1) ensure that the audit was conducted in accordance with applicable standards and meets the single audit requirements, 2) identify any follow-up audit work needed, and 3) identify issues that may require management attention.
